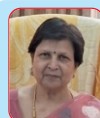

- Abstracts should be 200-250 words, clearly summarizing the research, objectives, methodology, key findings, and implications of the study.
- Submissions are accepted in English or Hindi language.
- All submissions must be prepared in Microsoft Word format, using Times New Roman, font size 12, and 1.5 line spacing.
- Citations and referencing should be in APA 7th edition style.
- Accepted abstracts will be notified via email within two weeks of submission.

Guidelines for Full Paper Submission

- Word Count: Typically ranges from 5,000 to 8,000 words, excluding footnotes and references
- Font: Kruti Dev or Times New Roman, size 12 points
- Line Spacing: Single-spaced

- Abstract: 300-500 words, summarizing research purpose, methods results, and conclusions

- Conclusion: Summarize findings, implications, and suggestions for future research
- References: Formatted according
